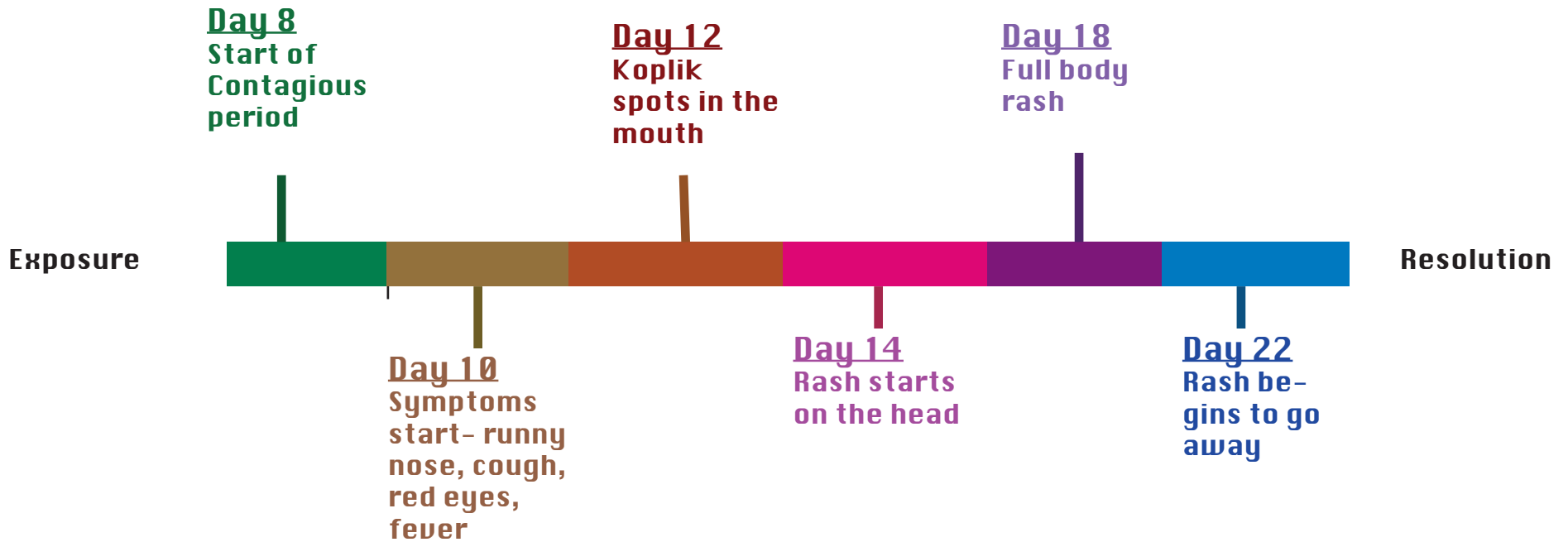


Measles Timeline

4 days before until 4 days after the rash starts

Updated Maps Every Wednesday
if your county is in the “Blue” your child may need an earlier MMR

This map is from April 23, 2025 and is updated every Wednesday.

Infants 6 to 11 months

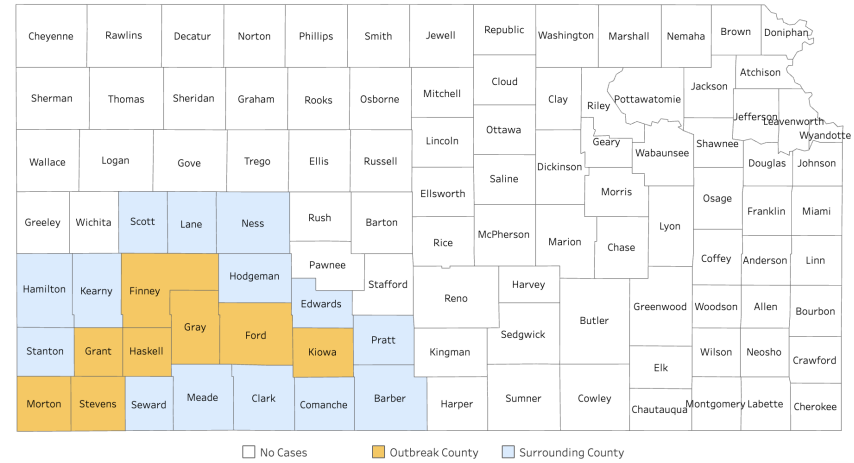
Infants may receive an early dose
Infants should receive another dose at 12–15 months
The final dose should be given at 4–6 years

Children 1-12 years

Children with 1 MMR need a 2nd MMR

Children who have not been vaccinated should receive one dose of MMR immediately

A second dose should follow after 28 days, at least, from the 1st MMR



Kansas 2025 Measles Outbreak Dashboard

The Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE) and Kansas local health departments are working together in response to a measles outbreak in southwest Kansas. As of Apr. 23, 2025, a total of 37 cases have been reported. The case counts are provisional and may change as cases are investigated by public health. The outbreak will be declared over after 42 days (two incubation periods) with no new cases. The dashboard will be updated every Wednesday.
